Bonus Youth Tournament
Tournament Rules and Format

1. **Eligibility:** All participants must be current youth members of the Greater Austin Area USBC Association for the 2013-14 season.
2. **Format:** Handicap singles tournament, participants will bowl four games on one pair of lanes.
3. **Fees:** \$15.00 entry fee (lineage & expenses)
4. **Handicap:** 90% of 230.
5. **Averages:** Entering average will be determined in the following order:
 - A) Highest GAAUSBC-Youth certified 21 or more game average as of March 29, 2014.
 - B) If 5A does not apply, entering average will be 231.

Bowlers that have both a USBC SPORT LEAGUE AVERAGE and a standard league average shall use the actual highest of the two averages. Any bowler who has ONLY A USBC SPORT LEAGUE AVERAGE must submit and use his/her adjusted Sport Bowling league average utilizing the USBC Average Adjustment Scale. The scale can be found on www.bowl.com, or in the USBC Playing Rules.
6. **Entry deadline:** 30 minutes prior to squad time.
7. **Date:** Saturday, April 19, 2014 at 12:30 pm.
8. **Practice:** 10 minutes.
9. **Dress code:** Clothing worn on the legs must be at or below the knee and cannot be worn below the waist. Bowler must also wear a shirt with sleeves. And the following will not be allowed: hats or caps, clothing that contains reference to alcohol, drugs, tobacco, sex, vulgar language, violence, gang related affiliation or other distracting symbols. No visible midriffs. Use of cell phones or electronic equipment will not be allowed while bowlers are in tournament play. Dress code will be enforced. No profanity of any kind will be tolerated. Any abuse of bowling center equipment, such as kicking, hitting or any other destructive behavior will not be tolerated, and may result in disqualification.
10. The tournament director shall decide all questions not covered by these rules.
11. Individuals may receive one scholarship award in the Bonus Youth Tournament and one scholarship award in the optional scratch event.

Optional Scratch Event-

1. **Entry Fee:** \$5.00 Guaranteed Prize Fund of \$50.
2. **Award ratio:** 1 in 8.
3. **Standings** will be determined by the total actual pinfall of the four games bowled in the Bonus Tournament.
